The Trust is now seeking exceptional individuals to join the Medical Committee of the Board. The successful candidate will bring senior experience, ideally at board level, of academic research and/or service delivery in the medical or related healthcare fields.

The Trust funds medical projects that are practical and capable of clinical application within five to ten years. The Trustees welcome applications directly from researchers at UK medical institutions or university departments concerned with:

- Improving the quality of life of older people suffering from physical or psychological disorders.
- The prevention of disease and disability in children.
- The prevention, diagnosis and treatment of tropical infectious and parasitic diseases.
- Innovations, involving any discipline, which are likely to improve health care.
- Innovations in medicine for caring for the needs of disadvantaged groups.

Recent grants have included projects in the following areas:

- Novel public health initiatives in low resource settings.
- Neglected parasitic diseases.
- Stroke recovery interventions.
- Developing new care pathways and training platforms to deliver improved patient outcomes.
- Pain and mental health issues in children with chronic disabilities.

The Trust values diversity on the Board of Trustees and makes appointment decisions based on an individual's experience, qualifications, merits and the needs of the Trust.
