

Guidelines for requesting and using the Trust's logo

The Sir Halley Stewart Trust logo is available for use by grantees, partner organisations and other organisations for specific purposes on a case-by-case basis, following approval by the Trust.

Please note that use of the logo is contingent on users adhering to the following guidelines:

- Users must inform the Trust of the specific purpose for using the logo, and wait for approval before using it.
- Requests should be sent to email@sirhalleystewart.org.uk, and include whether a colour version, black and white version or transparent version is required.
- Following approval of requests, the Trust will provide a suitable coloured high-resolution version of our logo.
- The logo must not be altered in any way, for example causing it to lose its integrity by stretching, or altering the colour palette. It should be large enough to be legible.
- Links to online content using the Trust's logo, or a digital / hard copy of the logo in situ must be provided to the Trust.
